

GRANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

GEORGE C. WADLEIGH FOUNDATION, INC.

1. Applicant must be a tax-exempt organization complying with the requirements of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
2. Applications will only be considered for grants that provide direct care or assistance for:
First priority: the aged indigent of Haverhill, Massachusetts.

Second priority: the aged indigent of Greater Haverhill (Merrimac, West Newbury and Groveland) Massachusetts.

Third priority: the indigent of Haverhill, Massachusetts and greater Haverhill, Massachusetts.
3. Applications seeking funding for the following purposes are encouraged:
 - Basic needs including Housing, Food, Clothing, Health and Transportation.
 - Capital expenditures.
 - Applications that combine a Wadleigh grant request with funding from other sources.
 - Startup costs for new programs will be considered for short term funding if the program will be self-sustaining thereafter.
4. No application will be considered from a previously funded organization until the Wadleigh Foundation has received a detailed accounting and evaluation of the previous grant.
5. Multiple grant applications from an entity within the same funding year are only considered in unusual circumstances.
6. Applications seeking funding for recurring operating expenses are viewed less favorably than requests seeking funding for non-recurring expenses.
7. The total funding for projects involving multiple funding sources cannot exceed the project cost.
8. Applications seeking funding for leasehold improvements must provide a copy of a long-term lease.
9. Recipients of grants payable in installments, must apply for each subsequent installment by providing an accounting and evaluation of the previous installment and confirming that the use of the installment being requested is consistent with the original application request.
